### **City of Zeeland COVID-19 Mitigation Measures (updated 10/9/2020)**

The City of Zeeland feels it is appropriate to implement recommended mitigation efforts around the Covid-19 Pandemic. City Administration is working closely with other local agencies on appropriate mitigation efforts and following the guidance of the Ottawa County Health Department, Ottawa County Emergency Management Office, Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention. #### Specific guidance for City Operations.

1. City sponsored gatherings shall adhere to gathering limits issued by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Order under MCL 333.2253, found here: [https://www.michigan.gov/documents/coronavirus/MDHHS\\_epidemic\\_order\\_-\\_Gatherings\\_masks\\_bars\\_sports\\_-\\_FINAL\\_signed\\_704740\\_7.pdf](https://www.michigan.gov/documents/coronavirus/MDHHS_epidemic_order_-_Gatherings_masks_bars_sports_-_FINAL_signed_704740_7.pdf) , or as further modified by subsequent orders by the MDHHS.
2. Provide Howard Miller Library operations in compliance with the Phased Re-Opening Plan for the facility.
3. Provide Howard Miller Community Center reservations in compliance with capacity limitations set by MDHHS Orders.
4. Provide Lawrence Park Pavilion reservations and splash pad operations in compliance with capacity limitations set by MDHHS Orders.
5. City Departments will implement their department specific COVID19 response plans to ensure the continued delivery of essential city services including the support of work from home if feasible.
6. Adhere to the City's Pandemic Illness Response Plan which serves as the City's Covid19 Preparedness and Response Plan (attached).
7. Prohibit travel to workshops/conferences/trainings unless approved by city manager/BPW General Manager (or their designee).
